- Validation \$ 32.00
- FFA Dues \$ 20.00
- Pen Rent \$50.00
- Cost of Supplies (Equipment)
- Chain/Rope Halter \$ 4.00
- Blanket \$ 25.00
- Sock \$ 17.00
- Shampoo \$ 10.00
- Brush \$ 10.00
- Mesh Muzzles (For Stockshow) \$ 9.50
- Shavings (For Stockshow) \$ 12.00
- Feed Bucket – 10” Clip-on feeders \$ 14.00
- Water Bucket – 5 gallon \$ 3.00
- Miscellaneous \$ 20.00 +

Expectations and Requirements:

- The animal must be fed and checked on at least twice a day
- The animal's pen must be cleaned regularly
- Pen rent and signed barn contract is due before the animal moves in
